

Strategy for RAISD Observatory of Forced Displacement

Objectives

The Observatory of Forced Displacement is an initiative of the RAISD Project, born with the aim of exchanging knowledge, research methods and results, as well as strategies and innovative practices for the attention and inclusion of forcibly displaced people (FDP), continuing the work of our Action Research Units (ARUS).

Specific objectives

- To contribute to the integration of FDP and alleviating their life conditions by assisting civil society organizations, researchers and other stakeholders in their daily work, and by actively engaging FDP in the activities.
- To promote collaborative, inclusive work methods and awareness raising in host/transit societies, and to shed light to the operative definition and practical implications of the concept of vulnerability context.

Philosophy

- We firmly believe that it is not the people that are vulnerable, but the situation and contexts that make persons vulnerable.
- We focus on exploring the underlying factors of the diverse contexts faced by FDP in the origin, transit and hosting societies.
- We believe in actively listening to FDP, in understanding their needs and in co-creating better attention and inclusion programs and policies.
- We engage in sharing information and experiences, offering opportunities for collaboration in research, assistance and training programs, and providing useful information.
